Over three days in September they will be arriving at a series of recommendations to give to the authorities on Transition, Suicide and Models of Care. These people will be privy to the entries which are in by this time and they could influence their thinking. You and they can truly help with changes for the better. Please don't be sparing with your ideas and interpretations. As my contemporaries in the sixties used to say, Let it all Hang Out.

We are keen to show the world what you believe Hope and Recovery looks like as we negotiate the possibility of an exhibition at the State Library of Queensland.
